

## RULES GOVERNING SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMS

- ❑ The group from which the recipients are selected must be reasonably related to the purpose of the scholarship; and, the group must be large enough to constitute a charitable class.
- ❑ The criteria used in selecting recipients should be related to the purpose of the scholarship.
- ❑ The person(s) who select recipients should not be in a position to receive a private benefit, directly or indirectly, if certain candidates are selected over others. Family members of the selection committee are not eligible for consideration.
- ❑ A report must be made to the Community Foundation, at least once per year, to determine that the recipient performed the activities that the scholarship was intended to finance.
- ❑ Records must be kept of individual scholarship awards.

### SCHOLARSHIP PROTOCOL

<i>Scholarship Name</i>	Mark Clute Mapping Technologies Scholarship
<i>Purpose</i>	To provide a scholarship for mapping technologies student(s), who intend to work in the government sector.
<i>Eligibility Criteria</i>	Student must be a sophomore or junior [enrolled in one of the 19 Michigan Colleges that offers an undergraduate degree in Geography]; have earned a CGPA minimum of 3.00 or higher; and have an interest in pursuing a career in mapping technologies within the government sector.
<i>Selection Criteria</i>	Completion and the timely submission of the application materials Personnel statement Declaration of financial need Academic performance
<i>Award Amount</i>	One \$1,000 scholarship
<i>Renewal</i>	Yes, if student maintains his/her eligibility
<i>Selection Committee</i>	To be composed of up to 3 members: the President of MiCAMP; a professor of geography from a public college or university in the State of Michigan; and one member of MiCAMP
<i>Application Process</i>	The special application form for this scholarship is available on the <a href="http://www.micamp.org">www.micamp.org</a> or the <a href="http://www.c3f.org">www.c3f.org</a> website
<i>Notification &amp; Award</i>	The recipient will be notified no later than June 1. The successful student may be recognized at a MiCAMP conference and/or Board of Trustees meeting.
